Project: Revival House of Glory International Church/Horn of Revival Ministry Weekly Food Palliatives to Most Needy Members

In October 2020, the Fund began discussions with the Revival House of Glory International Church (RHOGIC), Horn of Revival Ministry, located in Abuja, Nigeria, on the provision of food palliatives for their church members who were in need of food assistance. Food insecurity is a chronic problem among many in Nigeria, which has been exacerbated by the current COVID-19 pandemic, where over 145,000 cases have been reported to date. The church's Food Palliatives project provides vulnerable families with such food items as: rice, flour, cooking oil, salt, sea-

soning, beans, and canned tomatoes, among other items. The Fund wholeheartedly agreed to contribute to this worthwhile and timely effort by supporting 75 families with food packages that were distributed to families over the December Christmas holiday season. The Fund is committed to joining forces with our brothers and sisters on the African



continent, to heed the call of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ to feed the poor and hungry among us.

Thanksgiving Food Bags!

In a joint initiative in partnership with the outreach ministry activities of a church in the local Florida community, The Fund provided significant funding for food to aid needy families at Thanksgiving.

Since the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic in the early months of 2020, food insecurities have continued to plague many needy communities in the US as well abroad. During this crisis, the poor and most vulnerable among us have been hit especially hard. Children and the elderly in the communities are significantly adversely affected, and it is reported that 1 out of 4 have insufficient food. The teachings of our Christian faith, and the tenets of ethical human behavior, urge us to first remember the poor, the children, the widows, and the elderly among us. The Fund joined forces this holiday season with Encouraging Words Ministries, a local church in Brooksville, FL (ewmchurchinbrooksville.com) with the goal of feeding at least 100 needy families. We have committed to continuing to work with EWM's community outreach efforts to help with the food crisis on an ongoing basis.
